It has been a long time since our last newsletter! There are a lot of things happening around Project READ and in the Library.

First, we have 10 new tutors in our program, welcome! Thanks to all of you, we were able to provide over 3,700 hours in literacy instruction in 2010. Nice work!

Second, there is new carpet! It was installed the end of April in the original part of the library. Take a look, it is pretty now!

Third, there has been a change to the circulation policy for DVDs. Older DVDs will check-out for three weeks, just like books, while new, high-demand DVDs will still check-out for three days. The fines have

also changed, and not just for DVDs. The high-demand books and DVDs have a \$1 per day fine with no grace period. Other material has a 25¢ per day late fee with a five day grace period.

Finally, we have gotten some really great books. We have new GED and Pre-GED books-with CD, grammar books, reading material, and math workbooks. They are all on the shelf by the dictionaries. Take a look, they are fabulous resources. Also, if you would like to get a specific book for teaching your learner, just give me the info and I will try to get it.
