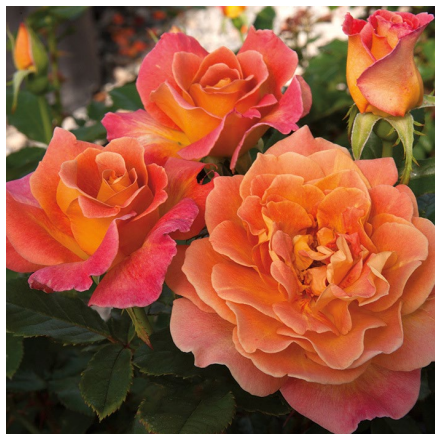

- A fragrant floribunda in hues of orange, gold, and pink.

Koko Loko (10)



--A uniquely colored floribunda with tones of lavender and chocolate brown.

Day Breaker (9)



- A vigorous floribunda mimics sunrise with its yellow buds opening to pink and apricot.

Neil Diamond (10)



- A showy hybrid tea streaked with vibrant red and white. Strong fragrance!

Neptune (10)



- A cool lavender hybrid tea with vigor and fragrance.

Marilyn Monroe (9)



-A gorgeous, apricot hybrid tea.

Dark Night (10)



-Dark red, velvety blooms with pale yellow reverse on the petals. Hybrid Tea.

Miss Congeniality (10)



-Striking grandiflora. White blooms are edged with vibrant pink.

Lord Mountbatten (10)



-Stately English rose with yellow blooms. Featured in Princess Diana's wedding bouquet.

Twilight Zone (10)



-This grandiflora has dark, velvety purple blooms with a strong fragrance.

Fragrant Lavender Simplicity (10)



-Fragrant, violet/mauve shrub rose.

Dainty Bess (10)



-Unusual single hybrid tea with creamy, pink petals and striking red stamens.

Electron (2)



-Hybrid tea with a strong pink color and heavy fragrance.

Gold Medal (4)



-Vigorous, fragrant, yellow grandiflora brushed with orange.

Iceberg (5)



-Abundant white flowers sometimes tinged pink. Floribunda.

Madame Hardy (1)



-Double white flowers with a green center.

New Zealand (1)



-Large, pink blooms on this hybrid tea.

Peace (5)



-This classic hybrid tea boasts large, yellow/pink, fragrant flowers.

Sally Holmes (2)



-Shrub with prolific tresses of single white flowers.

Touch of Class (2)



-Coral pink and cream on this vigorous hybrid tea.

Queen Elizabeth (2)



-All hail the queen! This hardy grandiflora holds aloft candelabras of classic pink blooms.
